## Re: Year 11 Prom Passport

We are delighted to announce that this year's Year 11 Prom will take place on **Friday 5<sup>th</sup> July 2019** at the AJ Bell Stadium, in conjunction with Flixton Girls School. This is a celebration of your son's achievements and successes during his time at Wellacre. In order to make it a true celebration of hard work, resilience and commitment to learning, **your son must meet the following requirements:**

1. Achieve 50 achievement points to receive the Prom Passport, issued from the week commencing 3/12/18.
2. Uphold our 'Core Values' and continue to collect achievement points from their subject teachers.
3. Attendance from the launch of the Prom Passport (3/12/18) to May half-term should be at 96% or more.
4. They should have **no** late to school or late to lesson marks on their registration certificate from 3/12/18 to May half-term.
5. They must attend all controlled assessment, revision and intervention sessions as requested by their subject teachers.
6. Their behaviour during the school day and at all examination sessions must be excellent.
7. They need to demonstrate a positive approach and commitment to learning – no C3 detentions, no referrals to the Isolation room and no fixed term exclusions.

If students fulfil these requirements as set out in the Prom Passport they will be considered for a Prom invitation. This will be issued after Easter. They may also be able to purchase a discount voucher using their achievement points via the Wellacre Rewards Shop and entered into the prize draw for a free Prom ticket along with various other prizes.

Students failing to meet the requirements will result in their Prom Passport being withdrawn. Students who have their Passport withdrawn will be placed on targeted monitoring by their Achievement Tutor, Year 11 Progress Leader or a member of the Leadership Team. The Principal reserves the right to refuse the sale of a Prom ticket to students not meeting the requirements of the Passport conditions and those who fail to meet our Academy expectations.

We hope that you will continue to support your son to ensure that these requirements are met as we look forward to celebrating your son's achievements at the Prom in July.
