### Behaviour for Learning policy 2019

#### Exclusions: Isolation, Fixed Term Exclusion (FTE), Permanent Exclusion

- Isolation (Internal Exclusion)** - requires a student to be removed from lessons as a consequence of inappropriate behaviour but does not require removal from the school premises. Students will complete their normal classwork in the Isolation room. Students will remain in Isolation until 3.30pm with the exception of Wednesday, when students will finish school at 4pm (normal time) but students will not be allowed to attend their P6 co-curricular option.
