We offer a signposting service for parent carers and service providers – **either online via the Trafford Directory, the phone line or by email.** We can signpost to services across Education, Health and Social Care across all age ranges; Children and Families, Young People and Adults/Older people. We can help with manual checks for Free School Meal eligibility and we can signpost to other teams in Education Services such as Virtual School, Vulnerable Pupils, Bullying etc, or Health, e.g. Mental Health Services, Speech and Language) or SEND services such as SENAS and SENDIASS.

If any of your parent carers or staff have early years children we can advise on childcare funding and direct them to resources to help them find a provider.

If you would be interested in learning more about how to use the Directory or the Local Offer we regularly deliver virtual bitesize learning sessions for both parent carers and practitioners.

The next session is scheduled for Tuesday 1st Feb 12.30 - 1pm. Alternatively a member of our Outreach team can come and deliver a training session at your setting.

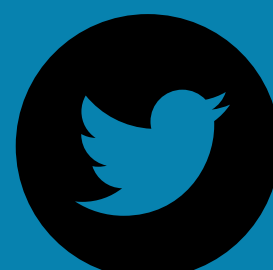
