Ofqual announced the return to pre-pandemic grading for Summer 2023. This means national GCSE results in England are lower than last year and more similar to attainment in 2019. *‘The return to pre-pandemic grading means that national results will be lower than last summer. It will be most meaningful to compare this year’s results with 2019, the last year that summer exams were taken before the pandemic. As in any year, results for individual schools and colleges will vary. The approach to grading means that results for individual schools and colleges are highly likely to be lower than last summer.’* (Ofqual blog, 10 July 2023)

The EBACC refers to a specific combination of subjects, it includes:

- english language and literature
- maths
- the sciences
- geography or history
- a language

Students at Wellacre are encouraged to complete the EBACC suite of subjects and the option process allows for these choices to be accommodated, however students are not compelled to do a modern foreign language.

Students are extremely well prepared for the next stage in their education, employment or training, with higher proportions than national in sustained education, employment or training in 2021, 95% of students were in sustained education, employment or training (Inspection summary report 13th December 2023)
